INSTRUCTIONS

Before the meeting, ask if anyone would like to be the Greeter. Greeters welcome people to the meeting in private message and tell them topics if they have been chosen. They ask the arriving person not to interrupt, and let them know they are available for questions. If the person does interrupt, the Greeter should kindly contact the person in private message.

Italics – follow these instructions as you go.

[Only registered hosts can send verifications]

To receive a verification of attendance meeting contact me both now at the end of the meeting in private message. This meeting is one and one half hours long and full attendance is required to receive a verification.

The Preamble

Marijuana Anonymous is a fellowship of people who share our experience, strength, and hope with each other that we may solve our common problem and help others to recover from marijuana addiction.

.

The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop using marijuana. There are no dues or fees for membership. We are self-supporting through our own contributions. MA is not affiliated with any religious or secular institution or organization and has no opinion on any outside controversies or causes. Our primary purpose is to stay free of marijuana and to help the marijuana addict who still suffers achieve the same freedom.

We can do this by practicing our suggested twelve steps of recovery and by being guided as a group by our twelve traditions. Marijuana Anonymous uses the basic 12 Steps of Recovery founded by Alcoholics Anonymous, because it has been proven that the 12 Step Recovery program works.

Who here is a marijuana addict?

[Pause]

We who are marijuana addicts know the answer to this question. Marijuana controls our lives! We lose interest in all else; our dreams go up in smoke.

~~ Poof! ~~

Ours is a progressive illness often leading us to addictions to other drugs, including alcohol. Our lives, our thinking, and our desires center around marijuana - scoring it, dealing it, and finding ways to stay high.

Is there anyone here new to Marijuana Anonymous or MA Online? Please introduce yourselves so we can welcome you!

[Pause]

Thanks for coming! A newcomer is the most important person at any meeting! Keep coming back! Newcomers are always welcome.

H O W do the 12 steps work?

Honesty Openness Willingness:

The practice of rigorous honesty, of opening our hearts and minds, and the willingness to go to any lengths to have a spiritual awakening are essential to our recovery. Our old ideas and ways of life no longer work for us.

.

Our suffering shows us that we need to let go absolutely. We surrender ourselves to a Power greater than ourselves. Here are the Steps we take which are suggested for recovery:

.

1. We admitted we were powerless over marijuana, that our lives had become unmanageable.
2. Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
3. Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God, as we understood God.
4. Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
5. Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
6. Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
7. Humbly asked God to remove our shortcomings.
8. Made a list of all persons we had harmed and became willing to make amends to them all.
9. Made direct amends wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
10. Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong, promptly admitted it.
11. Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God, as we understood God, praying only for knowledge of God's will for us and the power to carry that out.

12. Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these steps, we tried to carry this message to marijuana addicts and to practice these principles in all our affairs.

Do not be discouraged, none of us are saints. Our program is not easy, but it is simple. We strive for progress, not perfection. Our experiences, before and after we entered recovery, teach us three important ideas:

1. That we are marijuana addicts and cannot manage our own lives;
2. that probably no human power can relieve our addiction;
3. and that our Higher Power can and will if sought.

We celebrate with cheers and chips for special milestones – specified lengths of sobriety from marijuana, alcohol and all other mind-altering chemicals. We have virtual chips for 30 and 60 days. We have physical chips which can be mailed to you for 90 days, 6 mos, 9 mos, a year, 18 mos, and multiple years.

Is anyone celebrating a special milestone this week? We'll celebrate with you!

Please private message me if you'd like a chip sent to you.

Now would anyone else like to acknowledge their clean and sober time?

[Pause]

Congratulations to everyone who stayed sober today!

This meeting has some guidelines:

We ask that if you have had marijuana or any other mind-altering chemicals within the last 24 hours that you just listen and talk to someone after the meeting.

Please allow others to share without interruptions, comments, or advice. This provides safe space for a person to say what they need to say.

You can ask questions in the chatroom after the meeting.

To share, raise your hand with a '!' (exclamation point!) Please end your share with a 'ga' (go ahead) or 'pass.'

Please keep your sharing to 10 minutes or less so that we can let everyone have a chance to share.

This is a topic meeting of Marijuana Anonymous We will pick a topic or two. There are some great ideas on the list in the chatroom menu above (for those of you on a computer).

What recovery-related topic would you like to suggest?

Who would like to share first?

Now for MA Announcements :

This site depends on you! We're all in this together! Here are some things that you can do:

We need hosts to have more meetings. To be able to host you'll need some sobriety, a computer, the ability to copy/paste, and to have attended a few of our online meetings. The script is provided here. Ask an Admin about it, or explore the Hosting tab.

There are other ways to be of service, too! You need to have 6 months clean and sober to help out with things that require a password, such as treasurer or webmaster. Another great way to be of service is to hang out in the chatroom, because one addict talking to another is how we all stay sober!

Our online district is supported by financial contributions from ourselves. This is the 7th Tradition of MA, "Every MA group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions."
